**Qualifications/Experience:** Must have a diploma/degree in Child Youth Care, Social Work, Education or related field, good verbal and written communication skills. Previous experience working with children, youth and families would be a definite asset.

**Other requirements:** A current, clear Police Information Check, Intervention Record Check, driver's license, current abstract and vehicle are all required. Must be willing to work shifts and weekends.
